FS TO KFS ACCOUNTING STRING CROSSWALK

Summary: This document shows the conversion of the FS Accounting String to KFS Accounting String with examples for each type of account. KFS is Object Code driven, which means the KFS Object Code determines the type of accounting entry each transaction is.

FS	KFS	Explanation
Location	Chart Code	
Account	KFS Account	Used to distribute income or expense an account to one or more appropriate account(s).
Fund	Attribute of KFS Account	Used to record charges or debits directly assessed to a bank account created by banking transactions that do not automatically update the accounts in the system.
	KFS Sub-Account	
Sub	KFS Object Code	Used to record deposits going directly to the bank, without being verified through the normal cash receipts process (through the Cashier's office).
